

## **2025 AGM Ladies Handicap Report**

New members were issued with their initial handicap indexes during 2025

I would like to advise new members who are looking for a handicap index, to please ensure you have a marker who is affiliated to Golf Ireland, and that the cards are dated and must consist of 3 full 18 hole course scorecards or a combination of 9 hole scorecards. The scorecards must consist of 3 front 9 scorecards and 3 back 9 scorecards or combination of 18 and 9 hole cards as long as it's a full course combination, i.e. you cannot submit more front 9 scorecards than back 9 scorecards and vice versa.

Golf Ireland require, as per the rules of handicapping that the handicap committees conduct a handicap review annually of all club members.

The main objective of the handicap review is to assess whether the players handicap index is representative of their demonstrated ability and that their current scoring pattern is consistent with their expected scoring pattern. The handicap committee looks for anomalies within the players scoring record.

The annual handicap review must be performed by the 30<sup>th</sup> November and adjustments implemented ideally by the 15<sup>th</sup> December but no later than the 31<sup>st</sup> December, otherwise it may affect a player's eligibility for entry into Inter Club Competitions.

Players will be notified of any changes to their handicap index as part of the review.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all members of the 2025 handicap committee for their help and support during the year.
