

Amend Rule 10.1 to increase subscription rates by €50 and pro rata

PROPOSAL: Amend Rule 10.1 by deleting the monetary amounts shown and replacing them with amounts set out hereunder.

10.1 Annual subscriptions shall be:

Full Members €1130

Associate Members €615

Intermediate Members: See Rule 18.3 and Rule 18.4

Junior Members: €260

Cadet Members: €140

Student Members: €260

Juvenile Members: €150

Country Members: €260

Pavilion Members: €30

Overseas Members: Rate at discretion of Council

Amend Rule 10.3.1

PROPOSAL: Amend Rule 10.3.1 by the deletion of 2023 and replacing it with 2026

Current Rule

10.3.1 The levy to fund course development shall be €250 per annum payable by Full Members for a period of 3 years beginning in February 2023.

Proposed New Rule

10.3.1 The levy to fund course development shall be €250 per annum payable by Full Members for a period of 2 years beginning in February 2026.

Delete Rule 12.1 (see below) as there are no longer any Lady Associate Members

12.1 An Associate Member is a Lady who was in membership of the Lady Member category at 1.3.2001 and who has not exercised her right to transfer to Full Membership. This category of membership is closed to new entrants.

Amend Rule 12.2

PROPOSAL: Delete the final sentence and renumber the Rule as 12.1

Current Rule

12.2 A Five Day member is an Associate Member who may play the course from Monday to Friday inclusive subject to the requirements of the Club diary/fixture list. A Five Day member is not a Voting Member and is not eligible to serve on Council or on the committees of the Men's Club or the Ladies'

Club. For the 2017 Subscription Year, this category of membership is not available to persons who were Voting Members of the Club in 2016.

Proposed New Rule

12.1 A Five Day member is an Associate Member who may play the course from Monday to Friday inclusive subject to the requirements of the Club diary/fixture list. A Five Day member is not a Voting Member and is not eligible to serve on Council or on the committees of the Men's Club or the Ladies' Club.

Amend Rule 25.1

PROPOSAL: Delete the current wording and replace with proposed new rule

Current Rule

25. DISCIPLINARY ACTION

25.1 All disciplinary matters shall be dealt with by either the Men's Club or the Ladies Club as appropriate and in the event that either committee is unable to deal with a disciplinary matter then Council shall deal with the matter. Any decision to suspend membership or expel a member must be ratified by Council. The Men's Committee, Ladies Committee and Council shall at all times adhere to the principles of natural justice.

Proposed New Rule

25. DISCIPLINARY ACTION

25.1 All disputes and disciplinary matters shall be dealt with by either the Men's Club or the Ladies Club as appropriate and in the event that either committee is unable to deal with such matter then Council shall deal with the matter. Council shall appoint three members to carry out an investigation. Should the appointed members deem that a sanction should be imposed the person deemed to have merited such sanction has the right to appeal. Appeals will be dealt with by a different set of members appointed by the Trustees. Any decision to suspend membership or expel a member must be ratified by Council. The Men's Committee, Ladies Committee and Council shall at all times adhere to the principles of natural justice.

Current Rule

(9) At any time on Christmas Day or Good Friday.

(9) (9) At any time on Christmas Day.

Delete Rules 34.1 and 34.2 as they are no longer relevant.

34.1 Where time spent as a member is a qualifying criterion, time spent as a Lady Member shall count in lieu of time spent as a Full Member and time served on the Ladies Committee shall count in lieu of time served on the Council.

34.2 For the purpose of these Rules, time served on the Management Committee shall count in lieu of time served on the Council.

Amend Rule 34.3 to become Rule 34.1

34.3 Club correspondence shall be by electronic media unless a member indicates a preference for receipt of a hard copy.
